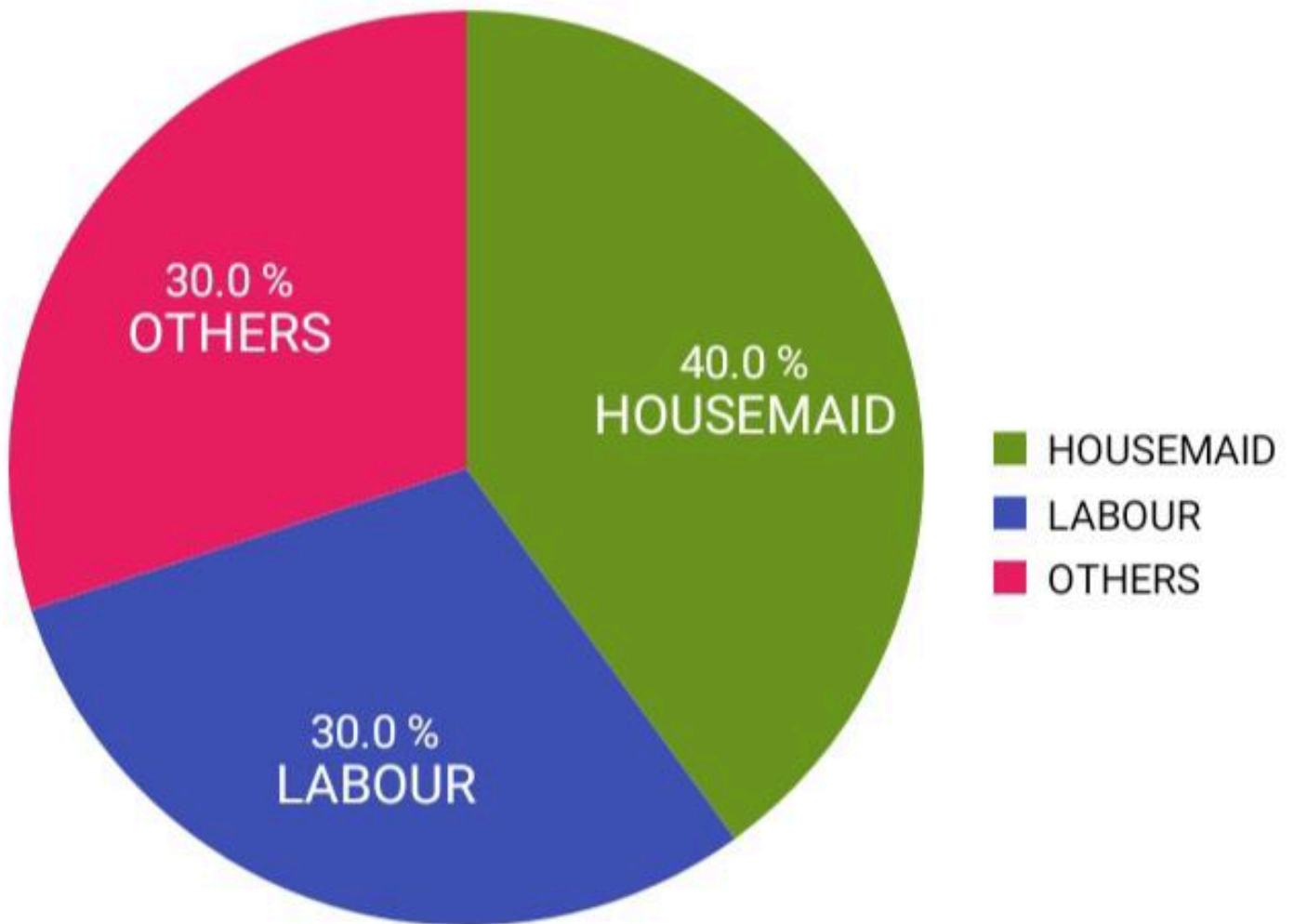

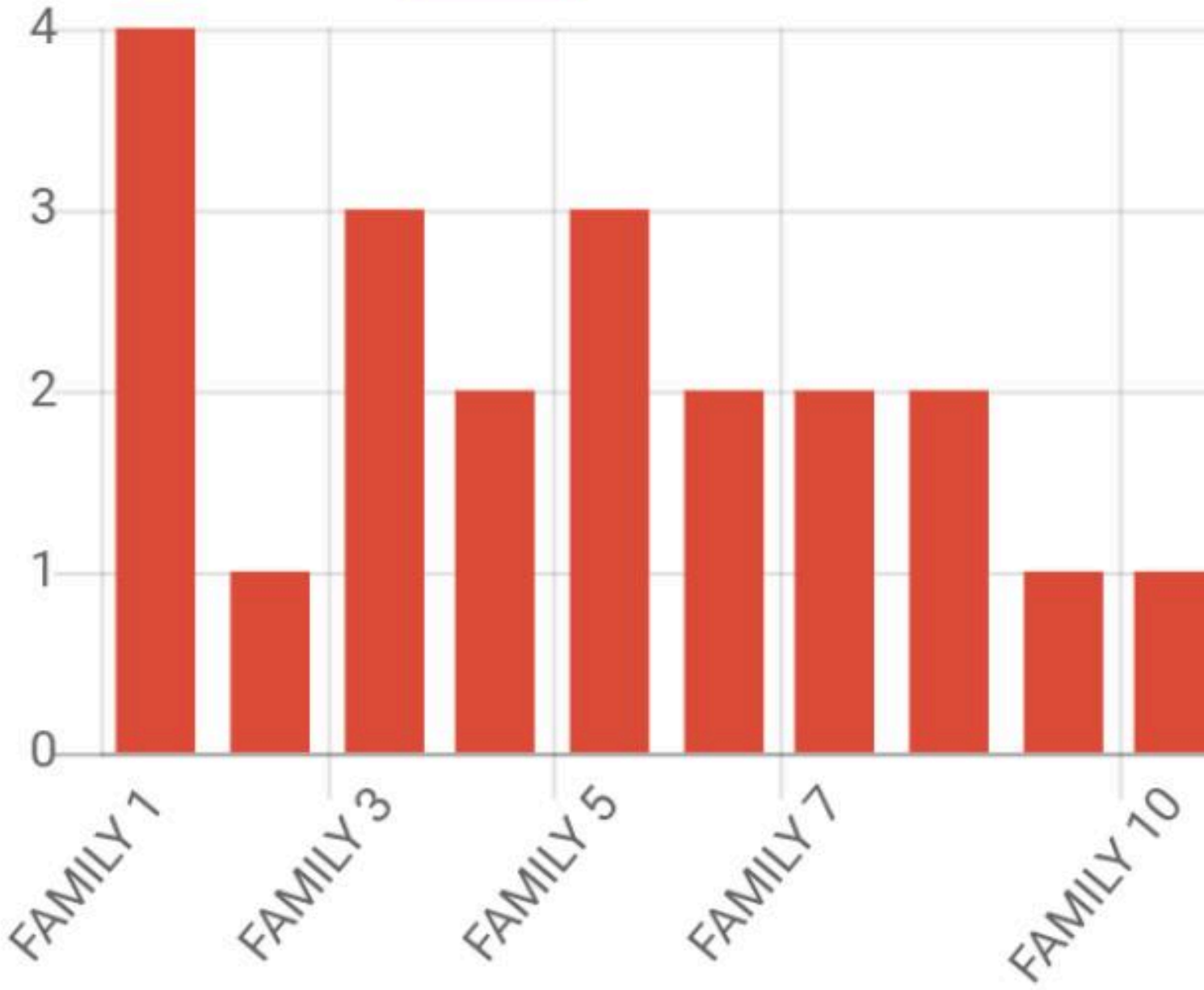

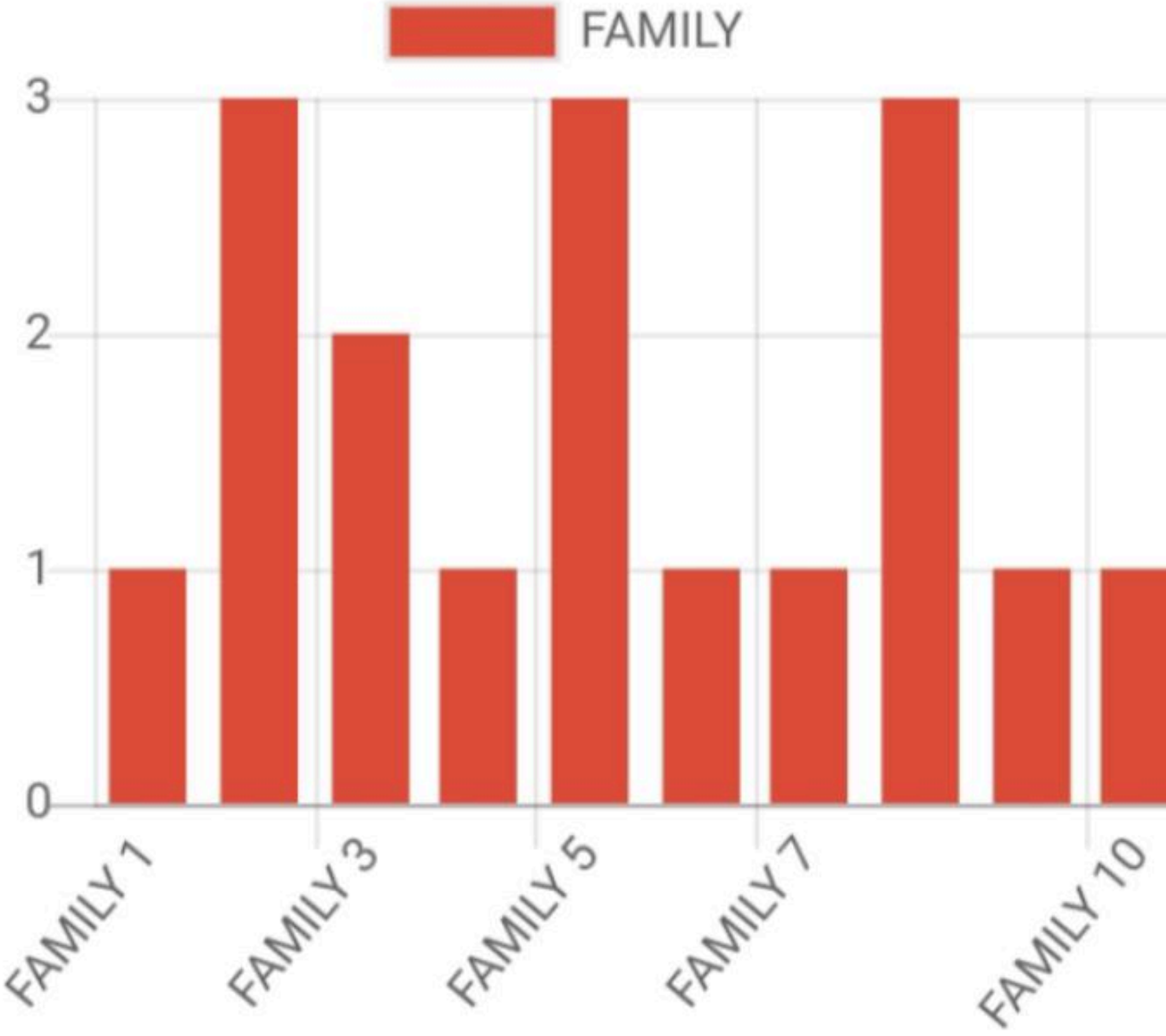


# NUMBER OF CHILDREN

FAMILY



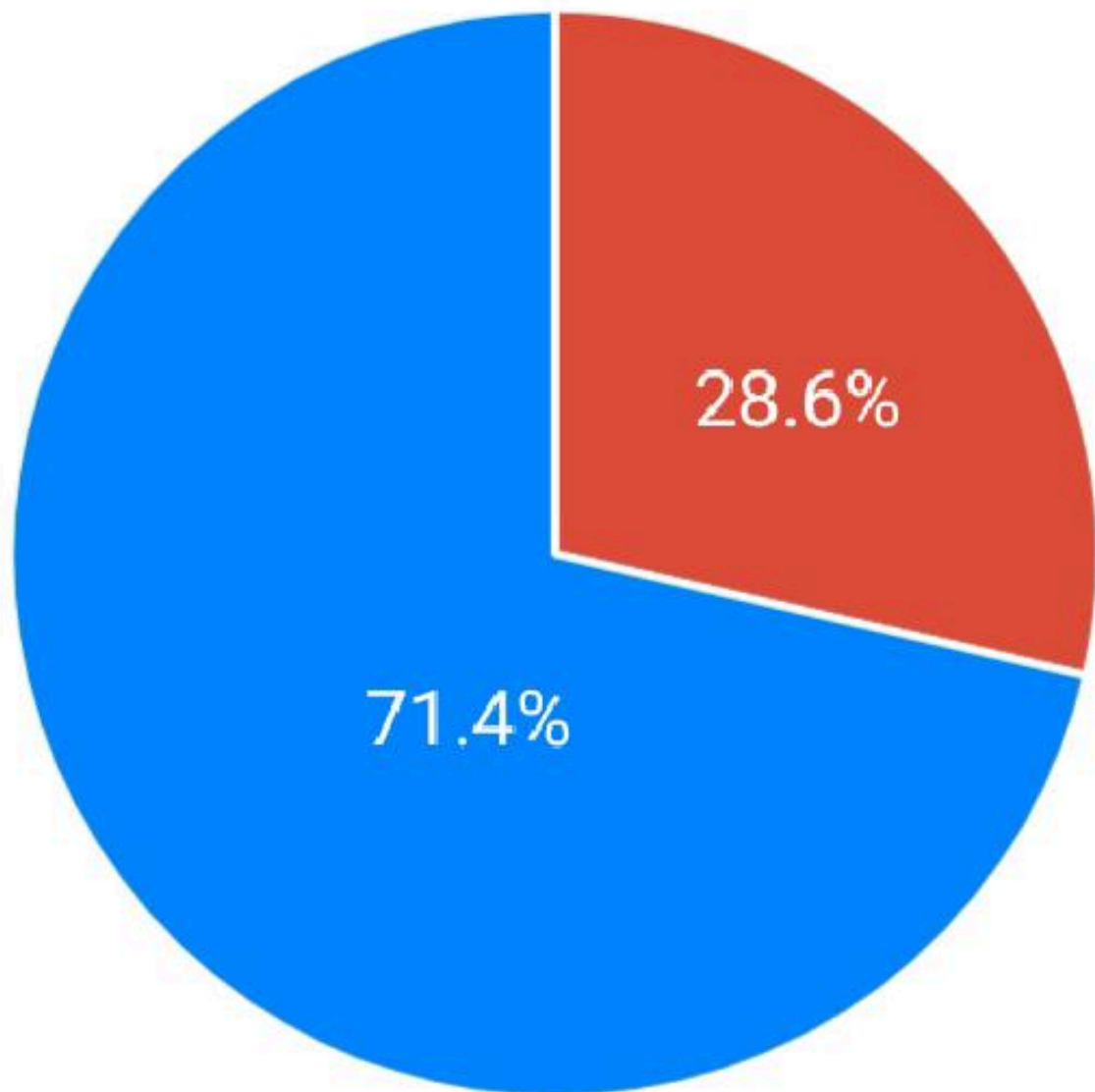
# NUMBER OF EARNING MEMBERS



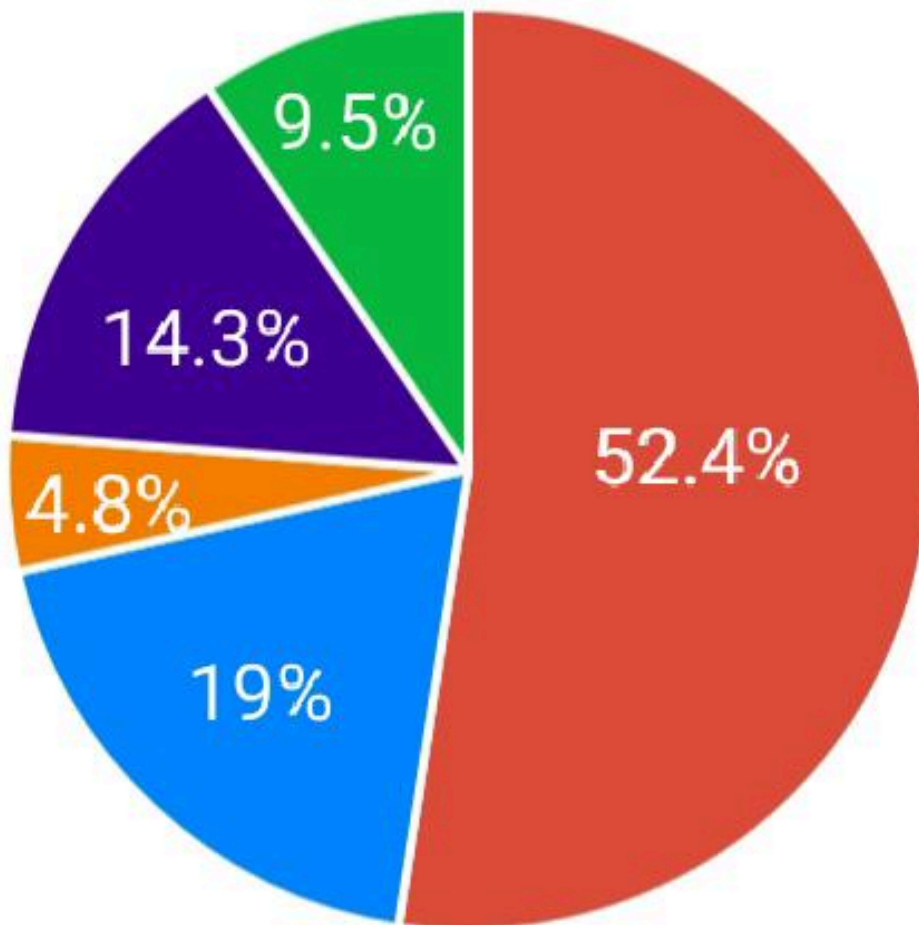
## RECEIVING ONLINE EDUCATION

 NOT RECEIVING ONLINE EDUCATION

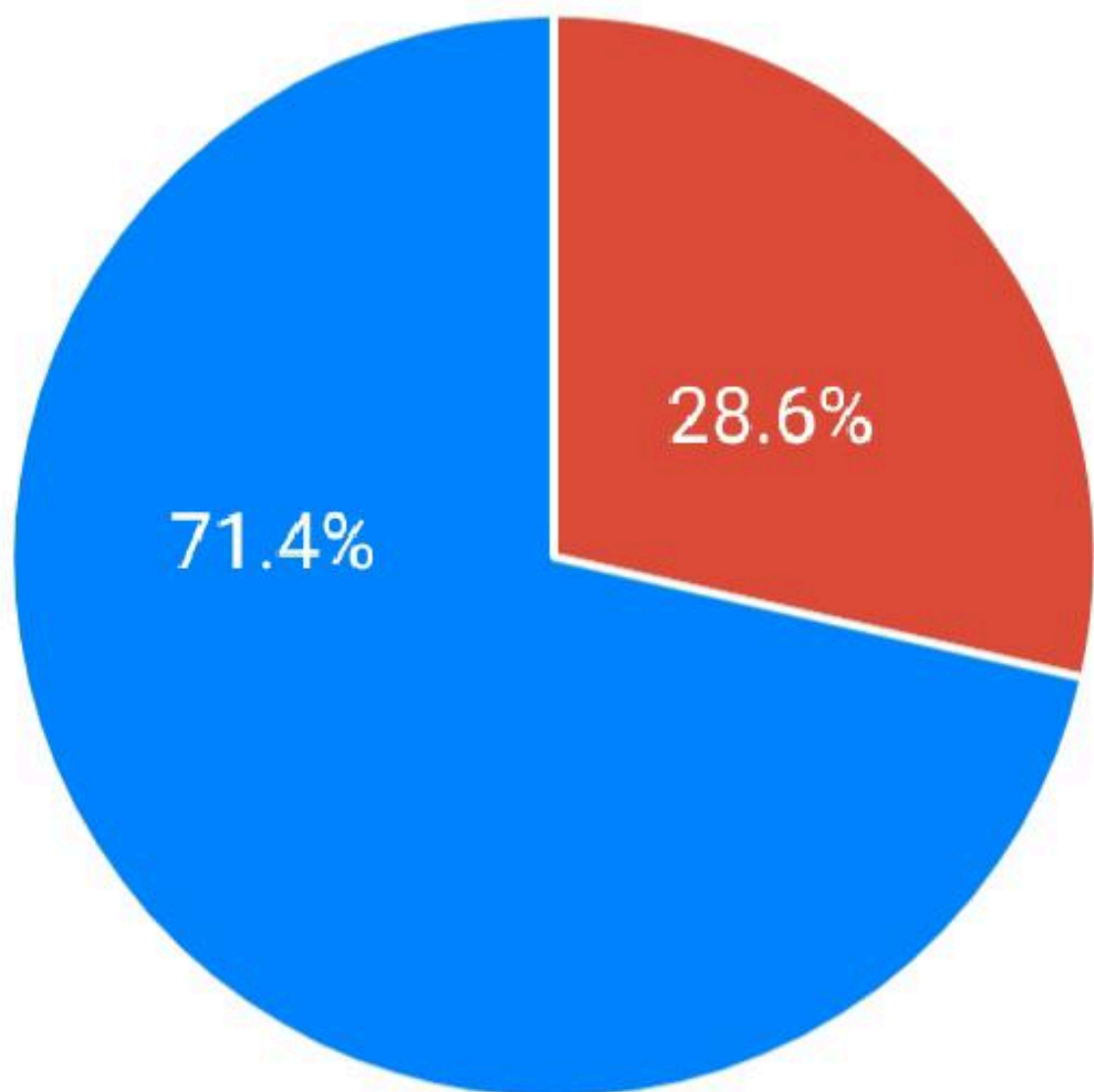
